Eight-Day Pilgrimage to Portugal & Retreat at the Byzantine Catholic Chapel in Fatima Oct. 26-Nov. 2, 2017

ITINERARY

DAY 1: Thurs., Oct. 26 - Boston/En Route

Depart from Boston for your overnight trans-Atlantic flight to Lisbon, Portugal.

DAY 2: Fri., Oct. 27 – Lisbon

AM: Welcome to Portugal! You will be met at the airport and transferred to your hotel. En route to the hotel you will enjoy a panoramic tour.

Lisbon's hills luxuriate with mosaic sidewalks, picturesque alleyways, and the haunting sounds of "Fado." It is an elegant old-fashioned city, which is never overcrowded and has both ancient and cosmopolitan atmospheres. One of its most famous sites is the Shrine of St. Anthony of Padua, or known here as St. Anthony of Lisbon.

PM: The afternoon is at leisure to relax or start exploring Lisbon on your own.

Dinner: Enjoy a welcome dinner at the hotel.

DAY 3: Sat., Oct. 28 - Lisbon/Obidos/Lisbon

AM: Sightseeing Tour of Lisbon

After breakfast, you will visit the church dedicated to St. Anthony of Lisbon, which was built where the saint was born in 1195. Celebrate Divine Liturgy at Santo Antonio Church (subject to availability).

Proceed to Commerce Square, one of the largest squares in Europe along the Tejo River to Belem. Belem is known for its role in the Era of Discoveries, featuring iconic buildings from the 15th and 16th centuries. Explore the beautiful Jeronimos Monastery built in the 1500s. The church interior unveils a gorgeous Gothic-Renaissance style altar, as well as the tombs of great Portuguese explorers. Stop in one of the oldest and most famous pastry shops in Lisbon to taste the delicious Belem Pastry. Continue toward the Belem Tower and the Monument of the Portuguese Navigators, two unique landmarks of Lisbon.

PM: Excursion to Obidos

After lunch, you will travel to Obidos, one of the most charming Portuguese villages, enclosed within the ramparts of a medieval castle. Walk through the bright small houses along cobblestone narrow streets. Stop at a typical tavern for a taste of the famous cherry liquor served in a chocolate glass.

Select from among the fine restaurants in Obidos for dinner on your own. Return to Lisbon

DAY 4: Sun., Oct. 29 - Lisbon/Nazare/Batalha/ Fatima B,D

AM: Visit Nazare

You will depart Lisbon and travel to Nazare, the most famous fishing town in Portugal. See the brightly colored rowboats moored on the beach, bathed by the Atlantic Ocean, and the women who wear the traditional seven petticoats.

PM: Excursion to Batalha

In the afternoon you will travel to Batalha for a visit to the superb Monastery of Santa Maria da Victória, built in 1388 to celebrate the 1386 victory against the Castillians in the Battle of Aljubarrota. It is the most beautiful example of Portuguese Gothic architecture. Later in 1509, the Unfinished Chapels and were added and, in 1563, the Renaissance Chapels and Cloisters.

PM: Continue to Fatima, the world pilgrimage center, for a retreat led by Father Thomas J. Loya. Celebration of the Divine Liturgy in the Byzantine Catholic Chapel of the Dormition.

Dinner: Enjoy dinner at the retreat.

This evening you will enjoy the candlelight procession (subject to availability).

DAY 5: Mon., Oct. 30 – Fatima B,L,D

AM: Retreat Morning

PM: Sightseeing Tour of Fatima

Visit the houses of the three shepherd children in Valinhos e Aljustrel and the apparition sites of the angel to the children and of Mary on Aug. 19, 1917. Then, enjoy a visit to the Basilica of Fatima, the Chapel of the Apparitions and the new Church of the Trinity dedicated to St. John Paul II.

Dinner: Enjoy dinner at the retreat.

DAY 6: Tues., Oct. 31 – Fatima B,L,D

AM: Retreat Morning

PM: Retreat Afternoon

Dinner: Enjoy dinner at the retreat.

DAY 7: Wed., Nov. 1 - Fatima/Santarem/Fatima B,L,D

AM: Retreat Morning

PM: Visit Santarém

Travel to Santarém to discover the Church of the Holy Miracle, home to a 13th-century Eucharistic Miracle. Celebrate Divine Liturgy at the Church of the Holy Miracle (subject to availability).

Return to Fatima.

Dinner: Enjoy a farewell dinner at the retreat.

DAY 8: Thurs., Nov. 2 - Fatima/Lisbon/Boston

You will be transferred to the airport for your return flight home. You return with wonderful memories and feeling culturally and spiritually enriched.

REGISTRATION AND DEPOSITS:

A deposit (by check) of \$1,000 p/person is required at time of registration, along with a signed registration form. You will be billed for the balance, which is due on or before Aug. 1, 2017 by check. All registrations received after Aug. 1, 2017, must be accompanied by full payment.

CANCELLATION TERMS:

Cancellations received:

Prior to Aug. 1, 2017: \$200 p/person; from Aug. 1-15, 2017: \$500 p/person; from Aug. 16-31, 2017: \$1,000 p/person; from Sept. 1, 2017 onward: no refund. **All cancellations must be received in writing.**

NOTE: Comprehensive insurance is available to cover trip cancellation and interruption, baggage protection, medical, accidental death & dismemberment and emergency evacuation and repatriation. A descriptive booklet will be mailed to you upon receipt of your deposit.

AIR TRANSPORTATION: Economy class via any regular IATA carrier. Any cancellation, itinerary change or failure to use confirmed air space may be subject to penalties levied by the airlines at the time of ticketing. **Air tickets, once issued, are non-refundable. This is in addition to above "Cancellation Terms."**

PASSPORT/VISA REQUIREMENTS: A valid passport is required for all tour members. U.S. citizens do not require visas for travel to Portugal. If you are not a U.S. citizen call the Consulate of EVERY country you will enter (even in-transit when changing planes) to check on visa requirements. **ALL passports must be valid for at least 6 months after the return date of the tour.**

TOUR PRICE DOES NOT INCLUDE: Passport, visa, and insurance, all items of a personal nature, beverages and meals not included in the tour. Gratuities to guides, bus drivers, tour escort, and hotel and restaurant staff. Optional tours and excess baggage charges. There is no refund for unused land arrangements or any cost incurred through absence or deviation from the stated itinerary for any reason, including illness.
